# **VEGETABLES SEEDS**

arugula asian spinach basil seeds/plants

beans, long beans

buckwheat seeds

cucumber seed

cucuzzi squash

eggplants, plants

garlic chives (sets/plants

luffa/ chinese okra

malabar spinach

millet seed

okra seed

peas southern, blackeyed

squash, butternut

sweet potato slips

tomatillo/seed

#### **PLANTS**

eggplants garlic chives rosemary, sage, thyme

<u>Plant Flowers Seeds or plants</u> mums, asters, marigolds, zinnias and wildflowers.

## Things to Do

FERTILIZE: Foliar feed all planting beds and lawns with Ocean Harvest or Neptune Harvest, BioForm Liquid.

(Bio-Form mixed with 1 Tb.. red cider vinegar per gallon of water) every two weeks.

PRUNE: Trim spent flowers stalks and blossoms from annuals and perennial to stimulate new growth.

<u>WATER:</u> Water your lawn as deeply and as infrequently as possible. Water garden & landscape more often.

Potted plants and hanging baskets daily or as needed.

### PEST CONTROL:

Grubworms: Apply beneficial nematodes.

Chinch bugs: Spray Neem oil or use the above.

Aphids: Safer soap, or Garrett Juice & Garlic Barrier.

<u>Fire Ants:</u> Green light Organic Fire Ant control, Citrex, Broadcast orange or grapefruit peelings or

pulp, Beneficial nematodes or try horticultural corn

meal & Dry molasses.

<u>Chewing insects:</u> Broadcast beneficial nematodes, dust natural diatomaceous earth or spray garrett juice with Garlic barrier add 2 ounces of orange oil per gallon for hard to control insects.

<u>Grasshoppers</u>: Apply diatomaceous earth stirred into the soil. Apply wheatbran, dry molasses and epsom salt mix to soil. Encourage birds.

Mosquitoes: Use SKEETER BEATER a garli barrier and K-Neem recipe. Ask for at Wabash.
