PLANT PERENNIALS

Plant: Spring & summer flowering perennials. Cool season grasses and solid sod. Fall color: Pansies, dianthus & snapdragons.

Things to Do

FERTILIZE: Foliar feed all plantings and lawns with Seaweed. Apply Native Mulch to garden beds.

- Bulbs, annuals and perennials with earthworm castings. Indoor plants with Lava sand and earthworm castings. Add 1 teaspoon of natural apple cider vinegar to irrigation water per gallon.

WATER: All planting area at least once, if no rain.

PESTS:

Brown patch in St. Augustine : Use cornmeal over infected area. To maintain a beneficial balance of microbes and fungi in your soil add "MicroGro" 5-lbs. per 1000 sq. ft.

Chewing insects: Broadcast beneficial nematodes, spray garrett juice with Garlic barrier add 2 ounces of orange oil per gallon for hard to control insects, Spray Garlic Pepper tea or Neem oil.

Grubworms: Apply beneficial nematodes. Treat infected soil with biostimulants, molasses, compost.

Chinch bugs: Spray with (fire ant control formula) with Neem product & follow up with beneficial nematodes one week later.

Aphids: Safer soap, or Garrett Juice & Garlic Barrier or

Fire Ants: Citrex, Broadcast orange or grapefruit peelings or pulp, Beneficial nematodes or try horticultural corn meal & molasses or use Green Light Fire Ant Killer with Spinosad.
