

# PLANTING ASPARAGUS CROWNS

## Preparing the beds:

- Prepare a bed at least 3' feet above standing water and the water table.
- Make the bed almost pure compost.
- Build a berm or a raised bed and dig down 6" inches. Remove all weeds and soil.
- If water sometimes stands in this area, build 30" inches high and 6" inches below the ground.
- Fill in with 24" inches of good sandy loam and top with 12" inches of high quality compost.

## Planting Crowns:

- Spread roots out flat.
